A great day for Jim includes a trip to the gym, a really, really good cup of coffee, some time reading the newspaper, making something good for supper which might include the barbeque, and watching a movie or singing some songs with the family. Jim and Ingrid achieved their family goal of driving across Canada and visiting every province with their children. The whole family still likes to travel together and enjoys hosting friends in their home.
